WHAT DOES BROWN COUNTY EMPLOYEES CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and Income ■ Amount Balance and Payment History ■ Transaction History and Credit History <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share Member's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their Member's personal information; the reasons BCECU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does BCECU share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No
For our marketing purposes— to offer our products and services to you	Yes	No
For joint marketing with other financial companies	No	Does Not Share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your transactions and experiences	No	Does Not Share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness	No	Does Not Share
For nonaffiliates to market to you	No	Does Not Share

What we do

How does **BCECU** protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does **BCECU** collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Open an Account or Deposit Money
- Apply for a Loan or Show your Driver's License
- Make Withdrawals from your Account

We also collect your personal information from credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Brown County Employees Credit Union has no affiliates*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Brown County Employees Credit Union does not share with non-affiliates so they can market you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *Brown County Employees Credit Union does not jointly market*

Other important information

Members of Brown County Employees Credit Union have the opportunity to review their information to make necessary changes to ensure that the Credit Union records are complete and accurate. Access to this information can be arranged during regular Credit Union office hours at a mutually agreed upon time.
